

Eligibility

- Open to artists 16 years and older, living within a 200-mile radius of Fairborn, OH.

Entry requirements & procedure

- Must be original 2D or 3D work.
- Must be inspired by a scene of Osborn Historic district/downtown Fairborn & created in 2020 before June 27. Work previously shown is not eligible.
- Work may be oil, acrylic, pastel, watercolor, print, drawing, or mixed media, photography or 3D hanging art less than 10 lbs in weight.
- Size not to exceed 30 x 40 inches
- All artwork must be labeled, framed, wired, and ready to hang. The gallery reserves the right to reject any work not framed or wired in a sound manner or in keeping with the conditions set forth in this prospectus of the art exhibition.
- Please prepare 2 copies of the entry form provided; information to include: Artist name, medium, price or NFS/insurance value. Attach 1 copy of the form A, B, or C to the back of your work & submit 1 copy with entry fee.
- All entries must be delivered to Fairborn Art Assn. Gallery on Saturday, June 27 2020, 1-3pm.
- B-W Greenway will retain a 20% commission on all works sold.

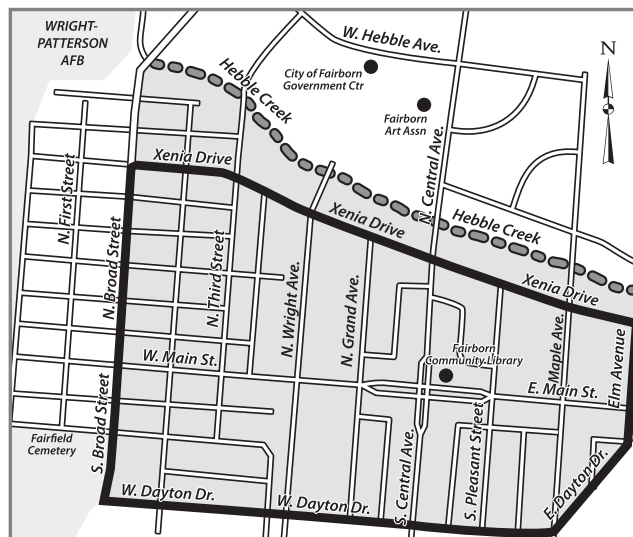
After the Dayton Flood of 1913, the village of Osborn was moved out of the Mad River floodplain and relocated next to its neighbor, Fairfield. In 1950 the two were merged as the city of Fairborn.

Fairborn, OH, is the home of Wright State University and Wright Patterson US Air Force Base. With Dayton, it shares the honor of birthplace of aviation as the site of Huffman Prairie, where the Wright Brothers did much of their testing and pilot training for their new aircraft.

The historic center of Fairborn is the subject of this year's juried art exhibition. The boundaries of the area are:

- **North** - Hebble Creek, running through the middle of town, 1/2 block past Xenia Dr.
- **South** - Dayton Dr
- **East** - Elm Ave.
- **West** - Broad St.

See map below. No permits are required for painting on public sidewalks or public land. Private land requires the owner's permission.
