

Eligibility

- Open to artists 16 years and older, living within a 200-mile radius of Fairborn, OH.

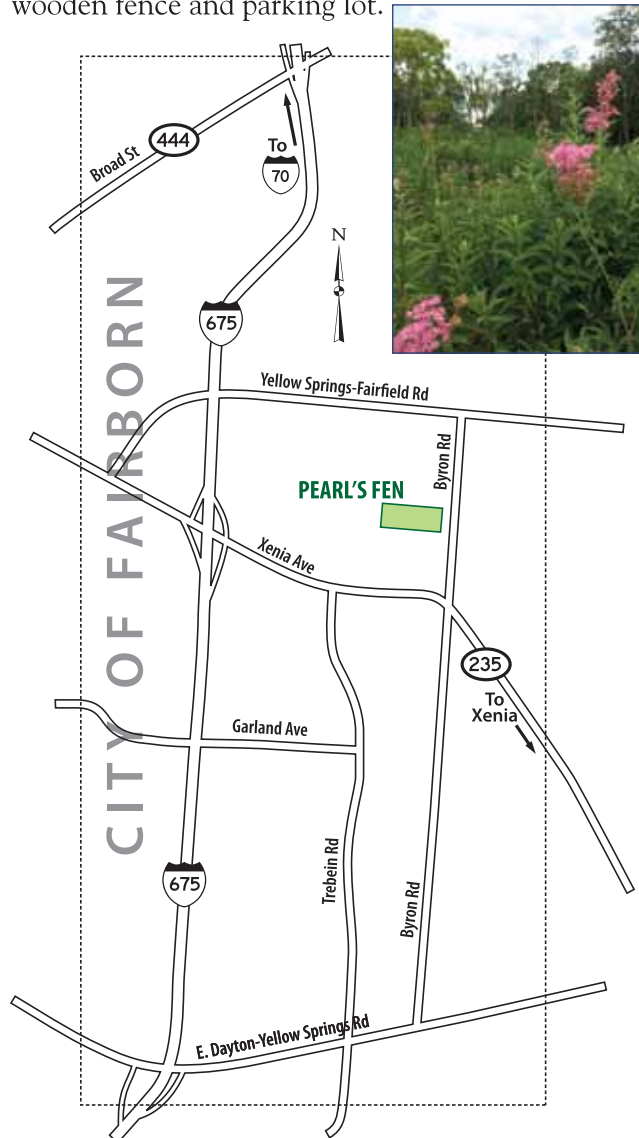
Entry requirements & procedure

- Must be original 2D or 3D work.
- Must be inspired by a scene of Pearl's Fen created in 2021 before June 27. Work previously shown is not eligible.
- Work may be oil, acrylic, pastel, watercolor, print, drawing, or mixed media, photography or 3D hanging art less than 10 lbs in weight.
- Size not to exceed 30 x 40 inches
- All artwork must be labeled, framed, wired, and ready to hang. The gallery reserves the right to reject any work not framed or wired in a sound manner or in keeping with the conditions set forth in this prospectus of the art exhibition.
- Please prepare 2 copies of the entry form provided; information to include: Artist name, medium, price or NFS/insurance value. Attach 1 copy of the form A, B, or C to the back of your work & submit 1 copy with entry fee.
- All entries must be delivered to Fairborn Art Assn. Gallery on Sunday, June 27 2021, 1-3pm.
- **B-W Greenway will retain a 20% commission on all works sold. Please price your work accordingly.**

Pearl's Fen

A fen is one of the rarest classes of wetland, containing a very high diversity of plant and animal life. Nearly 170 species of plants have been identified at Pearls' Fen. Their unique makeup produces deep organic peat soil which acts as a natural water purification system. Enter Pearls' Fen from Byron Rd, about 1/3 mile north of Rte 235 (Xenia Ave). There is no sign, but the entrance can be identified by a new 2-board wooden fence and parking lot.

Landscapes2021 is a juried art exhibition presented as a collaboration between B-W Greenway Community Land Trust & Fairborn Art Association. It was established in 2009 to heighten public awareness of our local greenspaces & the need to preserve them, as well as to foster an interest in creating art from nature.

Each year a different location in the Fairborn, OH, area has been chosen as the subject of the artwork. *Landscapes2021* location is B-W Greenway's Pearl's Fen. See other side for map & description of the area for inspiration.

Juror for the *Landscapes2021* Exhibition is Michael R. Roediger. Michael is Director & CEO of the Dayton Art Institute and is the 1st Director to be born & raised in Dayton. He is a member of the Assn of Art Museum Directors & serves as the Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Ohio Citizens for Arts. In his nearly 9 years at DAI, he has led the organization in retiring \$16M in debt; raised \$16M in capital & endowment funding in honor of the museum's centennial; and has overseen the renovation of the museum's historic grand staircases, fountains, & galleries, as well as making DAI more accessible for guests with disabilities. Michael holds a Master of Science degree in Leadership Development from Wright State University & a Bachelor of Arts from Ohio Northern University with concentrations in Communications, Public Relations & Theatre.
