Artwork may be paintings in acrylic, oil, watercolor, colored pencil, drawing, pastel, pen & ink, collage, photography, 3D works in sculpture, hand thrown pottery, and wood.

Size not to exceed 30x40 inches. All work must be original. It may not be a copy of a work by another artist, or a copy of a picture or photograph that has appeared in print. Works must be the artist's own concepts, composition, and execution, but a royalty free photo may be used as a reference.

Nudes, prints, or computer-generated work are not permitted in this show. All work must be easily moveable by one person. Threedimensional work must be stable and not hazardous to the public. Hanging work must have wire solidly attached to the frame for hanging (no saw tooth or ring hangers).

<u>For this year only</u>, any items sold may be taken home the same day and if sold before the judging of the show, a new entry may be brought in to replace the sold item.
